

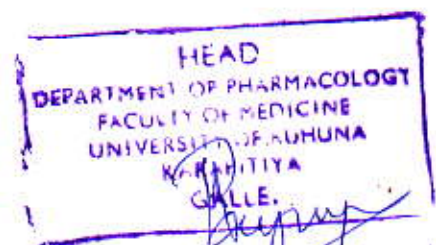
# 3<sup>rd</sup> MBBS Part II PHARMACOLOGY SECOND ASSESSMENT 39<sup>th</sup> Batch


Please note that all the assessments carry 20% of the total marks in the Pharmacology examination at the 3<sup>rd</sup> MBBS Part II Examination.
