Second Examination for Medical Degrees –November/2020

1. During the examination wearing a face mask is mandatory. The candidates who are without a face mask will not be allowed to sit for the examination.
2. The candidates are strongly advised to contact, respective Head of Department before commencing any component of the examination if they:
 - a. Have been diagnosed with COVID-19
 - b. Have been in close contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19
 - c. Have had any flu-like symptoms in the last fourteen days (from 15th November 2020 onwards), including fever, chills, cough, sore throat, or shortness of breath
 - d. Have been under fourteen-day home quarantine or centralized observation demanded by healthcare authorities
3. At the entrance to the examination area, forehead temperature of all the candidates will be measured with a contactless, thermal sensor.
4. Candidates will not be permitted to enter the examination hall with other students under the following conditions and will be asked to take the examination in a separate room.
 - If the temperature is above 37.3⁰ C
 - If the candidate is exhibiting flu-like symptoms (e.g. cough, difficulty in breathing, sore throat)
 - If the candidate has fulfilled any of the conditions stated in (2) above in this document

5. The seating arrangements and the time allocation for entering the examination hall is given below

6. University identity card or record book must be produced during the written examinations and practical examinations.
7. Possessing, using and entering the examination area or Departments with any electronic communication devices during the examination period is prohibited.
8. OMR answer sheet will be used to submit answers for MCQ question paper in all the subjects.
9. Students should bring 6B or above grade pencils, pencil sharpeners, pens and erasers. Water bottles, hand sanitizers, disposable gloves and medications are allowed. Due to health reasons, exchange of above items between students will not be allowed during the examination.
10. Candidates should not bring bags to the examination area.
